

HMIS Partner Agencies

The Solano County Homeless Management Information System (HMIS) is a shared database and software application which confidentially collects, uses, and shares client-level information related to homelessness in Solano County. HMIS is administered by Homebase on behalf of the Housing First Solano Continuum of Care (“CoC”).

Client information is collected in HMIS and released to housing and homeless service providers (“Partner Agencies”), which includes community-based organizations, non-profit organizations and government agencies. Partner Agencies use the information in HMIS: to improve housing and services quality; to identify patterns and monitor trends over time; to conduct needs assessments and prioritize services for certain homeless and low-income subpopulations; to enhance inter-agency coordination; and to monitor and report on the delivery, impact, and quality of housing and services.
